We are pleased to announce that the Open Access version of [Law in Context Issue 36 \(1\)](#) has been published.

Law in Context: A Socio-Legal Journal is a well-established double-blind peer reviewed journal publishing material dealing with contextual studies in law, culture, history, politics and social sciences. Its first edition was published in 1983, making it one of the earliest journals in the world to focus on contextual studies in law.

Much has changed since the first edition of *Law in Context* in 1983. In particular, the digital age is increasingly impacting on society, requiring appropriate ethical, political and legal responses.

In this new stage, [Law in Context](#) is Open Access, published online using the latest version of the industry standard publishing system OJS. All past issues are being digitised and will be made incrementally accessible online.

Law in Context is situated at the crossroads of legal studies, public and private law, legal culture and history, international relations, legal theory and jurisprudence, security, policy, privacy and data protection, judicial studies, and technology.

Law in Context bridges Law, Law & Society disciplines and Technology (including ICT, Semantics, (Natural Language Processing and Artificial Intelligence) from a social point of view. Articles on any topics related to these subjects and fields will be considered for publication.

All accepted papers will first be published on-line and then will be incorporated in the next available issue of the Journal. In addition to its traditional coverage *Law in Context* also welcomes video, coding, digital material, visual law and other non-traditional contributions relevant to law and society. All submitted material will be subjected to double blind peer review with a view to fast-tracked online publication of final submissions.
